BOE Committee to look at Flexible Boundary Policy

The Board of Education has initiated a conversation to take a closer look at the Flexible Boundary Policy (7:30-E). A committee will be meeting over the next few months to:

- Understand and clarify the original purpose of the Flexible Boundary Plan.
- Evaluate the Policy against its own stated priorities.
- Evaluate the success of the Policy in terms of equity of class size across buildings and efficiency of building use.
- Compare long-term numbers to program expectations.
- Recommend solutions and modifications to the Policy, if necessary.

To ensure sufficient representation, the committee is looking for one parent and one staff member from each school to attend monthly meetings. The first meeting will be **November 12th** at **7pm** in the **Hauser library**. All stakeholders are welcome to attend and participate in meetings. Subsequent meetings will be scheduled to accommodate parents, staff and community members.
