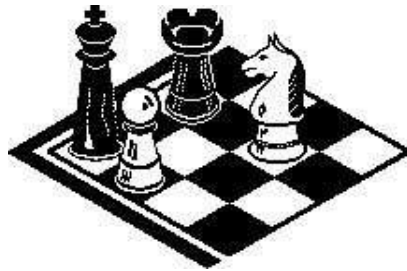


Central School and Chess Scholars
