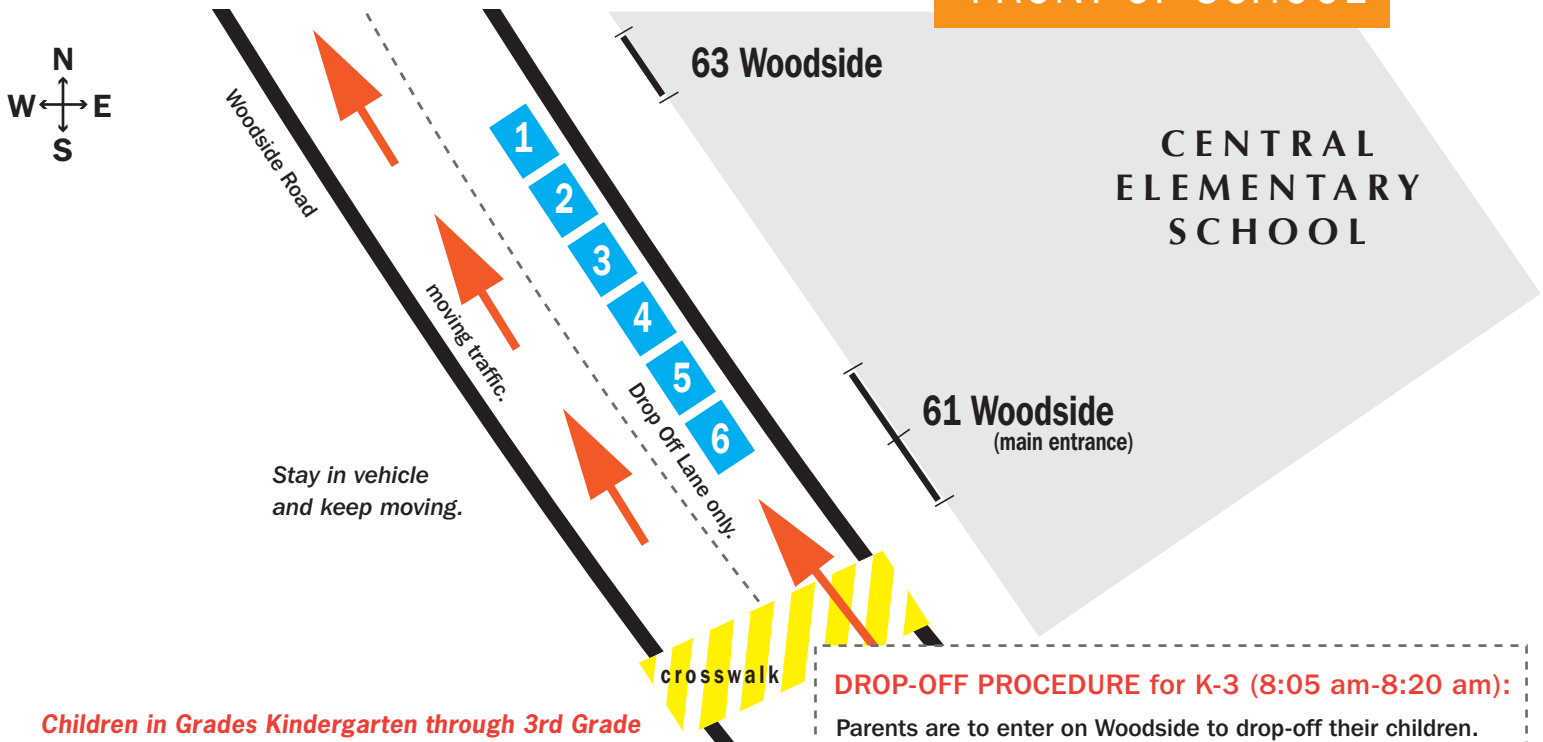


2011 CENTRAL SCHOOL TRAFFIC SAFETY PLAN

Riverside Police, Central Parents, and School Administration continue to identify traffic safety around Central School as a top concern. In partnership with the Riverside Police, the Central PTO and Administration sanctioned a Traffic Safety Committee to improve traffic safety. The Committee proposes the implementation of this **Traffic Safety Pilot Plan, effective Monday, May 9, 2011 through June 3, 2011**. Please note the **"Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures"** for Grades K-3, and for Grades 4-5.* The Committee will evaluate the Pilot, and your patience during this time is appreciated. Please take extra precautions when driving around Central School during drop-off and pick-up times. The safety of our children depends on your safe driving habits.

DROP-OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURES

FOR GRADES K-3 FRONT OF SCHOOL



Children in Grades Kindergarten through 3rd Grade will be dropped off and picked up in front of Central School on Woodside Avenue between 8:05 am and 8:20 am.

- Children should be dropped off or picked up on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- No child should run across the street in the zone or leave the car from the driver's side. **ONLY USE CROSSWALKS**
- Cross the street only at designated crosswalks.
- If you park in the Drop-Off Zone, you will be ticketed.
- No parking is permitted by the yellow marked curbs near crosswalks.
- Please remember Illinois law prohibits speeding or talking on your cellular phones in the school drop off zone.
- Children in Grades K-3 who walk to school will continue to line up in front of Central School. **NO CELL PHONES**
- Younger siblings of 4th & 5th Graders will be dropped off and picked up in the back of Central with the sibling who is in 4th or 5th Grade.
- Fourth and Fifth Graders will line up in the back by the East Doors.
- Grades K-3 will continue to line up in the front of the school.

NO PARKING IN YELLOW MARKED CURBS

DROP-OFF PROCEDURE for K-3 (8:05 am-8:20 am):

Parents are to enter on Woodside to drop-off their children. The children should be dropped off or picked up in the **6 designated car drop-off spaces** in front of Central School, **61-63 Woodside**. The first car pulls up to 63 Woodside Road. The Principal, Teachers, and/or Safety Patrols will be standing by the drop off spaces to assist children with getting out of the cars. Once students have exited the cars safely, the 6 cars will be directed to pull away from the curb. Then, the next 6 cars will pull into the spaces and follow the drop-off procedure. Children must not be dropped off in any lane other than the curb lane.

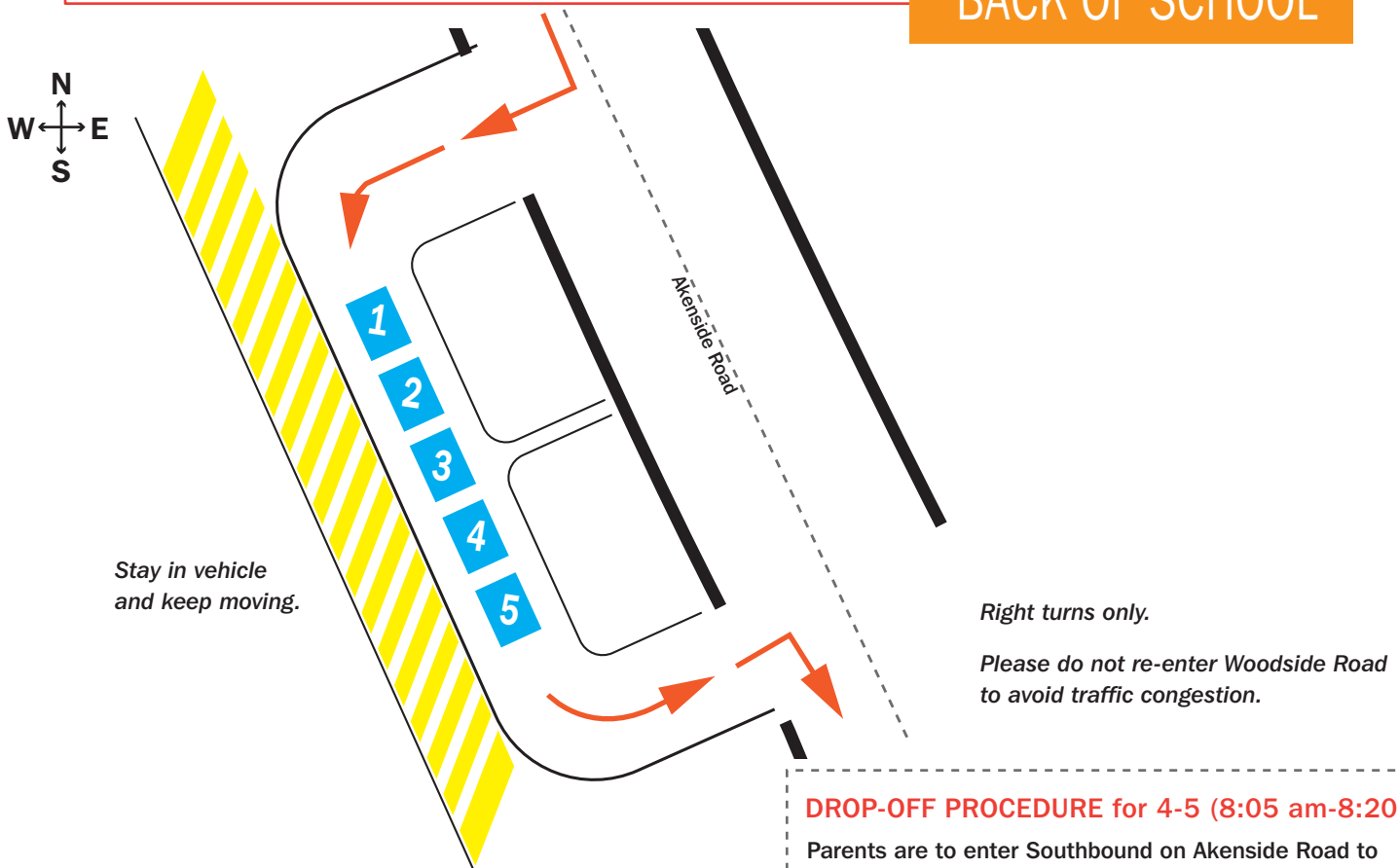
PICK-UP PROCEDURE FOR K-3 (3:10 PM-3:25 PM):

The pick-up procedure for Grades K-3 is similar to the drop-off procedure. Parents can pick up students by pulling into the 6 designated pick-up spaces in front of Central School. The Principal, Teachers, and/or Safety Patrols will assist students in getting into cars. Once the children are in the 6 cars, the cars will slowly drive away. Then, the next 6 cars will pull into the 6 designated spots and follow the pick-up procedures. To avoid congestion, please arrive no earlier than 3:10 pm.

DROP-OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURES

**FOR GRADES 4-5
BACK OF SCHOOL**



Children in Grades 4 and 5 will be dropped off and picked up in the back parking lot of Central School (entering Southbound on Akenside Road) between 8:05 am and 8:20 am

- Children should be dropped off or picked up on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- If you park in the Drop-Off Zone, you will be ticketed.
- No parking is permitted by the yellow marked curbs near crosswalks.
- Illinois law prohibits speeding or talking on your cellular phones in the school drop off zone.
- Fourth and Fifth Graders who walk will line up at the back door of Central, near the stenciled area.
- Fourth and Fifth Graders no longer will line-up in the front of Central School.
- A student who is tardy enters through the front doors of Central.
- Younger siblings of 4th & 5th Graders will be dropped off and picked up in the back of Central with the sibling who is in 4th or 5th Grade.
- *For Students who ride the Special Education Bus: The Bus will Drop-Off and Pick-Up Students in the Back of Central School.

DROP-OFF PROCEDURE for 4-5 (8:05 am-8:20 am):

Parents are to enter Southbound on Akenside Road to drop-off their children. Turn right at the first driveway into the back parking lot. The Principal, Teachers, and/or Safety Patrols will be standing by the drop off spaces to assist children with getting out of the cars. **The children should be dropped off or picked up in the 5 designated car spaces in back of Central School.** Once students have exited the cars safely, the 5 cars will be directed to **pull away from the curb to turn right onto Akenside.** Then, the next 5 cars will pull into the spaces and follow the drop-off procedure. Children must not be dropped off in any lane other than the curb lane.

Please do not re-enter Woodside Road to avoid traffic congestion.

PICK-UP PROCEDURE for 4-5 (3:10 PM-3:25 PM):

The pick-up procedure for Grades 4-5 is similar to the drop-off procedure. Parents can pick up students by pulling into the 5 designated pick-up spaces in the back of Central School. The Principal, Teachers, and/or Safety Patrols will assist students in getting into cars. Once the children are in the 5 cars, the cars will slowly drive away. Then, the next 5 cars will pull into the 5 designated spots and follow the pick-up procedures. **To avoid congestion, please arrive no earlier than 3:10 pm.**
