## Access and Circulation Study Summary

- **School District Only**
  - Develop Traffic Safety Documents (per school)
  - Pedestrian crossing signs (may also require Village approval)
  
- **Village of Riverside**
  - Restripe crosswalks
    - Central Elementary School – Hauser Junior High School – 5 crosswalks
    - Ames Elementary School – 3 crosswalks
    - Blythe Elementary School – 3 crosswalks
  - Pedestrian crossing signs
  - Widen sidewalks in front of Central Elementary School
  - Permanent one-way restrictions on Woodward Road (Central Elementary School – Hauser Junior High School) northbound.
    - Additional permanent one-way restriction on Akenside Road between Woodward Road and Longcommon Road.
  - One-way restrictions on Southcote Road during school hours. (Ames Elementary School)
  - Road closure during school hours on Repton Road in front of Ames Elementary School
  - Remove mid-block stop sign on Akenside Road east of Central Elementary School – Hauser Junior High School. Replace with yield signs/striping.
  - Install flashers/beacons on school speed zone signs on Kent near Blythe Elementary School.
  - Consider utilizing an adult crossing guard on Nuttall Road near Ames Elementary School.
  
- **Village of Brookfield**
  - Permanent one-way restrictions on Hollywood Avenue northbound (Hollywood Elementary School).
  - Restripe crosswalks
    - Hollywood Elementary School – 3 crosswalks
  - Pedestrian crossing signs
  
- **Illinois Department of Transportation**
  - Letter requesting retiming of 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue/Forest Ave Signal (joint letter with RB High School?)
