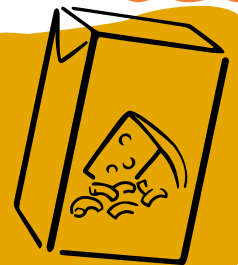
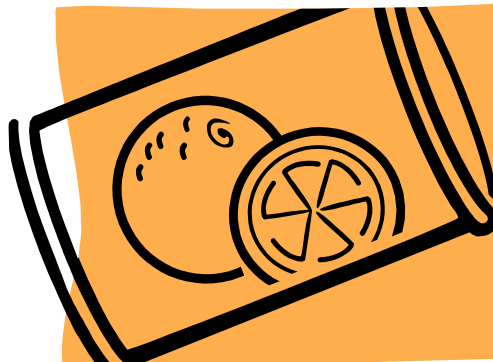


Hollywood School Food Drive

Help the hungry by donating food to the Greater Chicago Food Depository through One City, One Food Drive. Every one can make a difference.

Greater Chicago Food Depository, Chicago's food bank, is a non-profit food distribution and training center providing food for hungry people while striving to end hunger in our community. The Food Depository distributes donated and purchased food through a network of 600 pantries, soup kitchens and shelters to 500,000 adults and children in Cook County every year. Last year, the Food Depository distributed 58 million pounds of nonperishable food and fresh produce, dairy products and meat, the equivalent of 119,000 meals every day.

Your assistance is requested to help the Chicago Food Depository collect nutritious, non-perishable canned and packaged food that has yet to expire (no glass, please). Please consider donating one or more of the items below:

As a not for profit 501c3 organization, they depend on the generosity of communities to help meet the goal of finding new homes for as many animals as possible each year.

Each dollar the ACL spends on essential items such as kitty litter, paper clips, and soap is one less dollar they can use toward expanding their services and saving more animals. Please consider donating one or more of the items below:

Animal Care Supplies

- Kitty litter (non-clumping)
- Large garbage bags (33 gallon size)
- Cat toys (pipe cleaners, sparkly pompoms, feather wands, etc.)
- Catnip
- Dog toys (large rope toys, squeaky toys, kong toys...)
- Canned dog food (any brand)
- Dry dog food - Iams Adult (green bag), Iams Puppy (blue bag), Science Diet Adult, Science Diet Puppy
- Canned cat/kitten food, preferably ground poultry
- Dry cat food - Iams Digestive Care (pink bag), Iams Cat Food (blue bag); Science Diet Adult, Science Diet Kitten
- Soft or hard dog treats
- Cardboard box tops from cartons of paper or from cases of canned food (used as litter cage litter boxes)

Cleaning Supplies/Paper Goods

- Antibacterial hand soap
- Antibacterial hand sanitizer
- Liquid fabric softener
- Liquid bleach
- Laundry detergent (powder or liquid) (no tabs, please)
- Dishwasher detergent
- Antibacterial dish soap
- Glass cleaner
- Spray 409, Fantastic, Simple Green
- Sponges
- Fabric softener dryer sheets
- Clorox or Lysol antibacterial wipes
- Paper towels
- Paper Plates (6" size)
- Paper Cups
