## ECE

AM ECE students will meet at their regular time of 8:45-11:15am. AM ECE students should come to school dressed in costume in the morning. AM ECE students will participate in a classroom party in the morning. AM ECE students will be dismissed at 11:15am (as usual). Although it is not required, AM ECE students are invited to return *with parent/guardian supervision* at 1:00pm, dressed in costume, for the school-wide assembly and parade.

PM ECE students will meet at their regular time of 12:20-2:50pm. PM ECE students should come to school dressed in costume in the afternoon. They will participate in the assembly, parade, and classroom party.

## KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students will meet at their regular time of 8:20-11:15am. Kindergarten students should **not** come to school dressed in costume in the morning. Kindergarten students will be dismissed at 11:15am (as usual). The KITE program will **not** meet on Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup>. Although it is not required, all kindergartners are invited to return back to school at 1:00pm, dressed in costume, for the assembly, parade, and classroom party. Kindergarten students who return in the afternoon will dismiss at 3:00pm.

## GRADES 1 - 5

1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will have an extended lunch hour, from 11:30am-1:00pm. Students are encouraged to go home during lunch (with parent/guardian supervision) to change into costume. If students cannot go home for lunch, they can bring their costume to school and change into it after they eat. Students should return to school at 1:00pm, dressed in costume, for the assembly, parade and classroom parties.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Thank you to the PTA for providing a special afternoon snack for all students. Parents are requested not to send candy or other treats to school. Please make sure your child's costume is safe and appropriate. Masks and fabrics that interfere with movement can be a safety hazard. Although Halloween can be a time for "fright," please be sensitive to the needs of young children who may be frightened by violent, grotesque and bloody costumes. Fake weapons, fake blood, and other violent costumes are prohibited. We look forward to a safe and fun Halloween!
