

L. J. Hauser Junior High School Opening Days Highlights 2010

Monday, August 9 – *School office opens*

The school office will be open for business beginning August 9. Registration and payment of school fees may be done in person during late registration on August 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Gym uniforms (\$30) are to be purchased in the school office prior to the start of school. Registration fees for 6th graders included the purchase of a lock and a heart rate monitor strap. These items may be picked up in the school office beginning on August 9.

Thursday, August 19 – *6th grade orientation*

- Orientation will take place from 7:00-8:00 p.m.
- This orientation is for both parents and students.
- Sixth grade students will receive their class schedules at this time.

Tuesday, August 24 – *First day of school: 8:45 a.m.-11:30 a.m.*

- Students should arrive no earlier than 8:30 a.m.
- Lunch will not be served on this day.
- Seventh and eighth grade students will receive their class schedules.
- All students will attend all classes (shortened periods).
- Students are to come prepared with a pen, folder, and notebook paper. Complete supply lists can be found at <http://www.district96.org/resources/school-supply-lists-2/>. Teachers will discuss procedures regarding supplies with students on the first day of school.
- All students will attend “kick-off” Advisory meetings with administrative and student services staff during the first week of school.

September 13-17 – MAP testing

- The Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) assessment is called *Measures of Academic Progress* (MAP).
- MAP assessments are achievement tests that are taken on a computer.
- Students’ schedules will be revised during the testing window in order to assign all students to testing sessions.
