Boys and girls ages 11-15 can sign up for Red Cross Babysitting Training at the Brookfield Public Library. Taught by certified instructor Becky Huebler, the training program covers basic child care, CPR, safety, first aid, and helps students to develop skills in leadership and professionalism.

Sign up for any one of the following 3 sessions (you must attend both parts of the class to receive certification):

Session 1: March 21-22, both days 12-5:30 p.m.

Session 2: March 28-29, both days 12-5:30 p.m.

Session 3: April 5-6, both days 12-5:30 p.m.

A \$45 fee covers the cost of equipment, your handbook, babysitting bag, and your certification with the Red Cross, and is payable at the time of registration. Classes will be held at the Brookfield Public Library, 3609 Grand Boulevard, Brookfield, IL.
