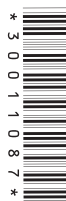

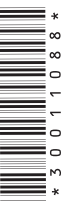

- 1 The Mexican gray wolves at Great Bear Wilderness do not have names. Why would they be jealous of the Chicago Wolves' mascot?
- 2 Keepers give the bears at Great Bear Wilderness plenty of stimulating training opportunities. How is that the same as the Chicago Bears?
- 3 American bison once had a cloud hanging over their head: they were hunted nearly to extinction. How did the Chicago Bulls' logo once seem to represent that situation?
- 4 In Habitat Africa! The Forest—north of Great Bear Wilderness—the chameleons change colors. Why do they share a designer with the White Sox?
