The **Frederick Law Olmsted Society of Riverside** invites Riverside-area students in grades 1-8 to submit their original "Reflections on Riverside" to our 2010 Student Poetry Contest.

Theme/Format: Poetry of any length or style which must reflect, or encourage reflection, upon any of Riverside's natural spaces.

Criteria: Time should be spent outside in Riverside's landscape for inspiration, though specific identifiers ("Riverside," "Swan Pond," etc.) are not required in the poem.

Judging is based on: **Strength of Theme** (10), **Appropriateness of Title** (5), **Meter/Rhythm** (25), **Originality** (25), **Clarity and Tone** (20), **Suitability of Verse Style for Subject** (10) and **Spelling and Grammar** (5).

- Rules:**
1. Poems must be the student's original work, created for this contest. Poems previously published, in print or on-line, are ineligible.
 2. Poems must be typed on letter-sized (8.5" x 11") paper. Elementary school students may receive adult assistance with typing.
 3. A completed Entry Form must be paper-clipped to the back of the Poem.
 4. Poems themselves must be free of student names/identifying information.
 5. One entry per student will be accepted. Entries will not be returned.

Prizes: The **Frederick Law Olmsted Society** will award:

\$ 25 to the winner from each participating Elementary school (multiple)

\$ 50 to the winner at the Junior High level (single)

Recognition: *Poems of the winners and runners-up* may be featured in the **Frederick Law Olmsted Society** Newsletter, on its Website, www.olmstedsociety.org and at physical installations at the Riverside Public Library and Brookfield Zoo. *One or more of these poems* will be imprinted on a rain barrel to be gifted from Riverside Public Library to Brookfield Zoo. *All entries* shall be published in professionally-bound volumes to be maintained in the Olmsted Collection and in the Local Authors Section of the Riverside Public Library.

Deadline: **Entries must be post-marked by May 1, 2010.**
