I further expressly agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees and Releasee's heirs, successors, assigns, executors, employees, and administrators against loss from any further claims, demands, or actions that may subsequently be brought by Minor or by any other person or persons on account of damages of any character resulting to Minor in any way from the foregoing activities. I further agree to reimburse and to make good to Releasees any loss, damage or costs Releasees may have to pay as a result of any such action, claim, or demand.
