

# **BROOKFIELD WANTS YOU TO BE COUNTED IN THE 2010 CENSUS!**

In the first half of 2010 the United States will conduct a Census to count everybody residing in the United States. Listed below are some facts regarding the 2010 Census:

**WHO:** All U.S. residents must be counted – people of ALL races and ethnic groups, both citizens and non-citizens. All information is confidential and is the property of the U.S. Census Department who cannot by law share collected information with any governmental agency.

**WHEN:** Census Day is April 1, 2010

**WHY:** The U.S. Constitution requires a national census once every 10 years. The census will show state population counts and determine representation in the House of Representatives. The Federal government can allocate more than \$400 Billion to states and communities

**HOW:** The ten-question Census questionnaire will be mailed to your house, in Brookfield via the U.S. Postal Service in March, 2010. Census Workers also will visit households between April and July 2010, to those households that do not return the questionnaires by mail.
