BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS, prepared by Dr. Lamberson, is a summary of the actions taken by the Board of Education. Official Minutes of the Board meeting held on April 20, 2010 will be posted on the District 96 website for public review following approval by the Board of Education, normally at its next regular business meeting.

April 22, 2010

The Board of Education held the Regular Business Meeting for the month of April on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 in the gymnasium at Blythe Park Elementary School at 7:30 p.m.

Principals presented anonymous profiles of District 96 students currently performing below standards on state assessment tests. Administrators discussed the wide array of strategies being utilized to support students in an effort to improve their academic performance.

The Board continued their discussion of the *Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village of Riverside and Riverside School District #96 Relative to the Provision of School Crossing Guard Services* as presented by the Village of Riverside. No action was taken on the agreement at this time.

The Board approved the replacement of Hauser's handicapped lift located at the north end of the building. The existing lift is out-of-service due to a broken frame.

The Board approved no increase in student fees for the 2010-11 School Year.

The Board adopted the 2nd Reading of Board policies under review as recommended by the Illinois

Association of School Boards in *PressPLUS Issues 68, 69, 70, and 71* and as amended by the Committee of the Whole on March 16, 2010. The updated policies will be incorporated into the Board Policy Manual located on the District 96 website.

The Board approved amended LADSE Articles of Agreement in anticipation of the possible withdrawal of DuPage County Community Consolidated School District 181 from the cooperative.

The Board accepted the bid from G.L.I. Services, Inc. DBA George's Landscaping in the amount of \$50,758 for the summer 2010 Central School Playground Project. This competitive price is well below budget expectations.

The Board approved elimination of the 5 emergency days from the 2009-10 Official School Calendar. The last day of school for the 2009-10 School Year will be Wednesday, June 2, 2010.
