## About Our Program



This program is provided by the Pav YMCA in partnership with Riverside Elementary School District #96. All before and after-school care

will take place at your child's school (Ames, Blythe Park, Central or Hollywood). Separately, **School's Out! Days** and school break camps (Institute days; half & early dismissal days; legal school holidays; and Thanksgiving, winter & spring breaks) will take place, if enrollment permits, at the Pav YMCA facility - 2947 South Oak Park Avenue in Berwyn.

Before and after-school care is offered every full day of school (Wednesday, August 25, 2010 through Wednesday, June 1, 2011).

### Program Hours\*

Morning care starts at 6:30am until the start of the school day. Afternoon care begins at the end of the school day and ends at 6pm.

### Program Pricing\*

Morning Care: \$50 per payment  
Afternoon Care: \$125 per payment  
Annual Registration Fee: \$25 per child

### Payment Terms

During the full school year, there are 18 payments. Payments are due on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month. A *non-refundable* first payment is due at time of registration.
